Plaintiff Microsoft Corporation ("Microsoft") writes to (i) inform the Court that the Ex Parte Order for Supplemental Preliminary Injunction entered on July 23, 2024 ("Supplemental Preliminary Injunction") (attached hereto as Exhibit 1) has been executed, and (ii) request that the documents sealed pursuant to the Order to Temporarily Seal Documents in Connection with Motion for Ex Parte Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Order, entered on July 23, 2024 ("Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Sealing Order") (attached hereto as Exhibit 2), be unsealed tomorrow, July 31, 2024.

On July 23, 2024, after the Court entered the Supplemental Preliminary Injunction, Microsoft served it upon VeriSign, Inc. ("VeriSign") and Vultr—the third parties identified in the Supplemental Preliminary Injunction whose infrastructure has been abused by the Defendants to perpetrate their fraudulent activity. Microsoft has since worked with those third parties to effectuate the Supplemental Preliminary Injunction. Specifically:

- VeriSign has changed the registrar of record for rockcaptcha.com to Microsoft's registrar of choice, MarkMonitor, Inc., and MarkMonitor, Inc. has changed the registrant of those domains to Plaintiff; and
- Vultr has disabled all services that it provided to rockcaptcha.com.

Microsoft has also served the Supplemental Preliminary Injunction and attendant papers specifically, Microsoft's Motion for an Ex Parte Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Order, as well as the Memorandum of Law and Declarations of Jason Lyons and Jason Rozbruch in Support Thereof—on Defendants by the email and publication alternative service methods previously authorized by this Court.

For the foregoing reasons, Microsoft respectfully requests that the documents sealed pursuant to the Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Sealing Order be unsealed tomorrow, July 31, 2024. Promptly upon that occurrence, and pursuant to the Court's Order dated July 25, 2024 (attached hereto as Exhibit 3), Microsoft will file on the public docket: (i) the Supplemental Preliminary Injunction and Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Sealing Order; (ii) Microsoft's Motion for an Ex Parte Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Order, as well as the Memorandum of Law and Declarations of Jason Lyons and Jason Rozbruch in Support Thereof; and (iii) Microsoft's Motion to Temporarily Seal Documents in Connection with its Motion for an Ex Parte Supplemental Preliminary Injunction Order, as well as the Memorandum of Law and Declaration of Jason Lyons in Support Thereof.

We thank the Court for its consideration of this matter and we remain available to confer about it at the Court's convenience.
